2. The Severn Valley benefice and St. Peter's, Chelmarsh PCC do not accept responsibility for the authenticity, attribution, genuineness, origin, authorship, date, age, period, condition or quality of any lot unless they have been instructed in writing by the donor/buyer, so to certify.
3. All statements whether printed in the catalogue or made orally as to any of the matters set out in (2) above are statements of opinion only and are not to be taken as being or implying any warranties or representations of fact by 'St. Peter's, Chelmarsh PCC' unless they have instructed in writing by the donor/buyers so to certify.

The Auction

1. The auctioneer has absolute discretion to divide any lot, to combine any two or more lots or to withdraw any lot or lots from the sale, to refuse bids, regulate bidding or cancel the sale without, in any case, giving any reason or without prior notice. He may bid on behalf of the vendor for all goods which are being offered subject to any reserve or at the Auctioneer's discretion.
2. The highest bidder shall be the buyer. The auctioneer may at his sole discretion, determine the advance of bidding or refuse a bid. If, during the auction, the Auctioneer considers that a dispute has arisen, he has absolute discretion to settle it or to re-offer the lot.
3. Each lot is put up for sale subject to any reserve price placed by the vendor. Where there is no reserve price, not otherwise, the seller has the right to bid either personally or by one person (who may be the Auctioneer).

Third Party Liability

1. Every person on the premises where the auction is being held, at any time, shall be deemed to be there at their own risk. He/she shall have no claim in respect of any accident which may occur or injury, damage or loss howsoever caused, save in so far as the injury, damage or loss shall be caused by negligence of benefice staff/volunteers, in which case we have third party liability insurance.

Reserves and unsold items

1. All goods are put up for sale without reserve, unless consent has been given by the auctioneers prior to the commencement of the sale.
2. In the event of any reserve price not being reached at auction, St. Peter's PCC are empowered to sell after the auction, by private treaty at not less than the reserve price, as long as the goods remain on site. In the event of such a sale by private treaty the Conditions of Sale applicable to a buyer governing the action will not apply.
3. Items unsold can either be returned to the donor, if requested, prior to the auction or will be removed and sold on elsewhere by the church to which the original donation was made.

Payment

1. **Please do not collect items you have purchased during the sale.** Within each hour of the auction space will be given to retrieve items purchased **AFTER** payment has been made in the office. A receipt will be given marking the lot numbers purchased which can be given to one of the stewards who will retrieve the item(s) for you.
2. There is a 5% buyer's premium to be added to sale items cover costs. Anything remaining of the premiums will be given to the 'Chelmarsh Parish Hall' as a donation.
3. **Unfortunately, we cannot accept card payments.** Payment can be made by cheque made out to the relevant church, or cash.
